All participants must maintain assigned position throughout the parade route

**NO LARGE ANIMALS!** (All animals must be on a leash at all times)

**NO POLITICAL CAMPAIGNING** on candidacy or issues

## REGISTRATION/POSITION ASSIGNMENTS/JUDGING

Registration: from 8:00 to 8:30 am at 2700 East & Evergreen Avenue on day of parade

Parade Chair will have final say on suitability to participate in parade

All participants and floats will be given a position assignment

Judging of floats will take place along the parade route

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Awards will be awarded to the best entry for:

Theme, Creativity, Originality, Craftsmanship, Presentation

Prizes and awards will be presented from the Grand Stand at 11:00 am.
